It can help me have a fun and comfortable time.



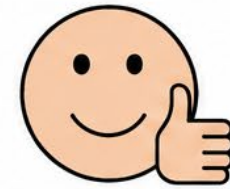

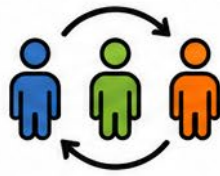

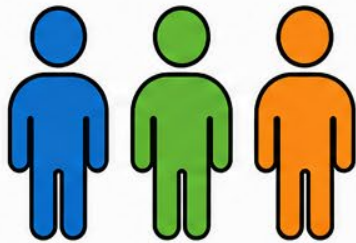

Staying Safe and Following the Rules



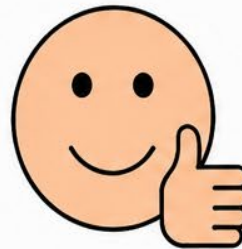
I can remember to stay with my family or friends and be sure to follow all of the rules for the day at the Fair.

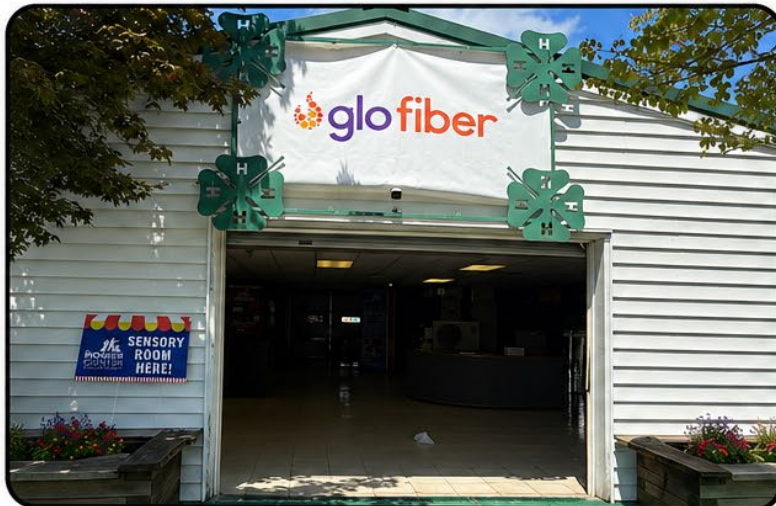
